Preface to the First Edition (1979)

The following index was compiled to help us read *Gravity's Rainbow* in a tutorial at Wesleyan in the Spring of 1977. We worked further on it in the summer of 1977, when one of us (Tölölyan) was doing research on WW II at the Imperial War Museum in London and the other (Leighton) was also living in London. We thank Wesleyan University for the research funds which enabled us to do some of the work, and the National Endowment for the Humanities, whose summer grant enabled the senior author to work in London.

The *Index* is by no means final. We keep discovering omissions in it. But we have also decided that waiting for exhaustiveness is no longer worthwhile, especially since the publication of *Pynchon Notes* has created a network of those likely to profit immediately from the use of this index.

We have indexed all proper names, acronyms and capitalized nouns, using the Viking [since 1987 Viking/Penguin] edition for all page references.

The senior author would appreciate receiving corrections and notice of omissions.

Note to the Second Edition

Since the *Index* was first compiled, our knowledge of *Gravity's Rainbow* has increased, making it possible to answer some questions lingering from the first edition and to correct some other features necessary. Although this endeavor continues, this version was helped greatly by the publication of Steven Weisenburger's *A Gravity's Rainbow Companion* (Athens, GA: U of Georgia P, 1988). Support for the initial effort to transfer the first edition of the *Index* to computer files came from the Department of English at the University of

Wisconsin-Eau Claire, and special thanks go to Polly Emerich (with the assistance of Jenny Stelse), who input the text of the *Index*. The present second edition goes beyond the efforts in the 1989 "Reset" edition and corrects errors that had crept in as well as adding some items that had been overlooked from the outset. Last, we want to thank Meredith Weber for her extraordinary work proofreading this new layout for the *Index*; any remaining errors or gaffes are the compilers'.

For those readers who might still use the Bantam edition of *Gravity's Rainbow*, Jody Gilbert has worked out a conversion formula which should get users within one page (+/-) of the reference:
